Weekday Masses. To access Masses streamed from around the Diocese please look on the Leeds Diocesan Webpage & click on the "Online Weekday Mass" icon offering live-viewing or a view later facility via a YouTube channel.

Attendance at Holy Mass. On Monday 19th July HM Government rescinded legislative powers put in place to assist with the limiting of the transmission of the Covid-19 Virus. In response to this the Catholic Bishops' Conference of England & Wales issued a Statement (available on our websites) encouraging the adoption of a "cautious approach to capacity and activity within our buildings, especially at corporate acts of worship." They further say that the anticipated date for the resumption of the Sunday Obligation is the First Sunday of Advent (27th/28th November 2021). In light of this & the "Step 4 Guidance" issued by the Conference, we are advised to (a) Sanitise Hands on entry to church (b) to wear Facial Coverings which reduce aerosol or droplet spread (c) Ventilate buildings well (d) maintain a good general standard of Cleaning using detergents on hard surfaces especially touch points. In addition to this advisory guidance as long as the NHS Test, Track & Trace system is in operation details of those entering our churches will continue to be required. (It is worth noting that the NHS themselves are continuing to operate a Covid-safe policy including the wearing of facial coverings, social distancing & sanitisation in their facilities i.e. GP's surgeries & hospitals).

Bank Closure. With the closure of the Cleckheaton branch of HSBC (the bank used by the Diocese of Leeds) the nearest branch is at Brighouse. In light of this parishioners are invited to give consideration to the use of a Standing Order in favour of either of our churches. A Standing Order Mandate can be downloaded from our webpages or requested from Fr. Nicholas, & returned to him upon completion by the donor. N.B. For those taking out a Standing Order for



accountancy purposes it would be helpful if these could be paid on a monthly basis. Thank you! Returning to Church. Encouragement is given to those who are hesitant about returning to Holy Mass. Please do think about coming to one of our weekday Masses to 'dip your toe in the water'! We have now been open for a full year & continue to maintain high standards in regard to keeping our congregations safe. **Booking Seats at Mass.** (a) It remains advisable to book a seat (on-line / by phone) if you are intending to attend a weekend Mass. (b) The obligation to attend Holy Mass currently remains suspended.

Spiritual Communion. If you are unable to come to Mass in person please join us through a time of prayer & reflection at home. A prayer to help you benefit from Spiritual Communion is: At your feet, O my Jesus, I prostrate myself and offer you repentance of my contrite heart, which is humbled in its nothingness and in your holy presence. I adore you in the Sacrament of your love, the ineffable Eucharist. I desire to receive you into the poor dwelling that my heart offers you. While waiting for the happiness of sacramental communion, I wish to possess you in spirit. Come to me, O my Jesus, since I for my part, am coming to you! May your love embrace my whole being in life and in death. I believe in you, I Sacrament of Reconciliation. If you would like to avail of the Sacrament of hope in you, I love you. Amen.

Reconciliation please make an appointment with Fr. Nicholas. As our Reconciliation spaces in both churches are not adequately ventilated, other locations will be offered.
