<u>Attendance at Holy Mass</u>. ALL PARISHIONERS are to respect the following guidance in regard to their arrival/ attendance at church: (a) Facial Coverings are to be put on prior to entering church; a Distance of 2 meters is to be maintained between different households; Hand-Sanitisation must be done by everyone entering our churches. (b) For ALL Masses: attendees are expected to be seated in church 5 minutes before Mass begins in order for everyone to spiritually prepare for Mass (including our volunteer Stewards & Fr. Nicholas). Booked seats WILL NOT be reserved beyond 10 minutes prior to Mass.

Second Collection. Thank you to those who gave so generously to last weekend's second collection for Peter's Pence which raised £185.77 (Holy Spirit £68.90 & St. Paul's £116.87) Bank Closure.
