

Weekday Masses. To access Masses streamed from around the Diocese please look on the Leeds Diocesan Webpage & click on the "Online Weekday Mass" icon offering live-viewing or a view later facility via a YouTube channel.

Creating a Safe Environment fot the celebration of Holy Mass. In light of the "Step 4 Guidance" issued by the Bishop's Conference we are advised to continue to (a) Sanitise Hands on entry to church (b) wear Facial Coverings which reduce aerosol or droplet spread (c) Ventilate buildings well & (d) maintain a good general standard of Cleaning using detergents on hard surfaces especially touch points. In addition to this advisory guidance as long as the NHS Test, Track & Trace system is in operation the details of those entering our churches will continue to be required.

Second Collections. Retiring Collections will be taken THIS weekend for the Catholic Education Service & NEXT weekend for Home Mission Sunday. From Parish to Mission & The Synod of Bishops. Evolving from the Diocesan Pastoral Council Bishop Marcus is launching an initiative entitled "From Parish to Mission" which, due to the timescale of the latter, will now coincide with a request from the Holy See issued by Pope Francis in May to engage with the Universal Church in preparatory work for a Synod of Bishops in Rome (2023) titled "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission." To be an integral part of this process of listening a Parish Meeting (November – December) will be held in each parish of the Diocese where parishioners will be asked to consider questions given by the Holy See. In order that these meetings are led in such a way as to ensure that everyone has an opportunity to speak Facilitators from across the Diocese will attend these meetings in groups of three. Currently Facilitators are being sought; if you feel that you could help with this please contact Fr. Nicholas by Thursday 23rd September. There will be two training days for Facilitators, at Hinsley Hall, Leeds, on 16th & 23rd October (Saturdays). Facilitators will not be asked to visit parishes with their own area. September Changes. (a) Our seating capacity in both churches has increased in line with the easing of national restrictions. Stickers on pews are in place to assist parishioners to identify where to sit respecting a social distance for their own well-being & considering that of others. (b) Whilst singing at Mass the advisory guidance offered is that we sing

whilst wearing a facial covering. Hymnbooks are picked up on arrival & left on an identifiable table as you leave Mass. (c) The booking of seats for attendance at Mass assists with the requirement to record the details of those entering our churches. You may wish to continue to book a seat on-line to assist with this (now NOT necessary for weekday Masses), but if not it remains advisory that names & telephone numbers be recorded on entering church. As a community we have a duty to create environments in which people feel safe & comfortable to worship, not least giving consideration to the

most vulnerable. Returning to Church. Encouragement is given to the hesitant to think about coming to one of our weekday Masses; it is important that we begin to see the numbers attending Mass increase.

Donation. Grateful thanks are expressed for a substantial anonymous donation given in memory of Bryan & Doreen Summerscales for the benefit of Holy Spirit Church. In gratitude for this Fr.
